


Git4C: Installation Guide

Requirements

1. Graphviz for PlantUML support - available in most linux distributions in package repository

Installation

1. Go to the Atlassian Marketplace
2. Search for 'Git4C - Git Viewer For Confluence'
3. Click 'Install'

Configure your plugin
